2004-2005 UDCSSA Presidential Election Timeline

1. **Saturday May 1 2004**- Nominations begin via e-mail to udcssa@yahoo.com. Any Chinese student/scholar may nominate himself/herself or another eligible student/scholar for this position. Nominations must be in writing.
2. **Thursday May 6, 2004** – Nominations close
3. **Saturday May 8, 2004** – Deadline for submission of candidate biographical information (via e-mail to udcssa@yahoo.com), pictures and bios will be distributed on UDCSSA website.
4. **Sunday May 9, 2004** – Candidate forum to be held during this week, open to all UD Chinese students and scholars via UDCSSA website and IECC email board
5. **Saturday May 15, 2004** – **Election Day** from 9:00 AM until 11:59 PM, all Chinese Students and Scholars vote for the 2004-2005 UDCSSA President via email to: udcssa@yahoo.com. All votes in email distributed by “@udel.edu” is effective for this election.
6. **Monday May 17, 2004** – Current president Peng Liu reveals the presidential election result.
7. **Saturday May 22, 2004** – Newly elected UDCSSA president announces all new committee members to Chinese students and scholars in UD and Chinese community in Delaware via UDCSSA and IECC email board.

Position Description

President

- Appoints all chairpersons for committees or subcommittees established by UDCSSA and serves as the official spokesperson for UDCSSA
- Assures fair and equal representation of Chinese students and scholars within the University and to Chinese Embassy in Washington DC
- Acts as moderator at all UDCSSA subcommittees and general student body meetings
- Organizes an agenda prior to subcommittee body meetings for the students and scholars
- Receive all resolutions and recommendations of UDCSSA subcommittees
- Organizes UDCSSA or designates another UDCSSA subcommittee to prepare picking up event for the newcomers in Fall'04 and Spring'05, Newark Community day event, the annual Spring Festival party held by UDCSSA in University of Delaware, the 2005-2006 UDCSSA presidential election and any other events.
