## INDIVIDUAL REFERENCES: THOSE BEGINNING WITH A CAPITAL LETTER

If a reference begins with a capital letter, the **first two characters** are the surname code (see "The Ancestry" printout). It is an individual Census, Vital Statistics, Newspaper or Letter record and is identified by a four character code. If the **third character** is a number, it is a census record and refers to the decade the census was taken. The **last character** in the census reference uses the upper case first letter of the first name of the youngest direct male ancestor in the household. Second priority is given to the youngest direct female ancestor (wife, widow, etc.) of the youngest direct male ancestor. If no direct ancestor, use a lower case first initial of the head of household. Use "Q", etc to distinguish 1900 from 1800. If more than one direct family line is on the same census sheet, priority goes to the youngest direct male ancestor. If the **third character** is a lower case letter, it is one of the following records:

The **fourth character** in these references is usually the first letter of the first name of the person of the record (sometimes a **fifth character** to avoid duplication) & is a capital letter if he is a direct ancestor (otherwise, lower case). If there are **only three characters** it is a letter from the person of the 3rd character.
